

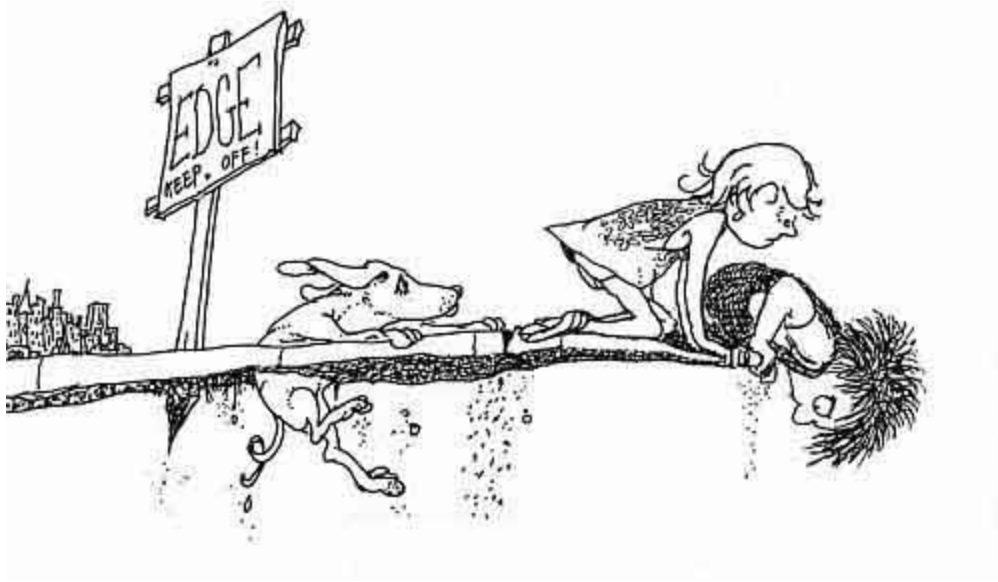


Open to rising 3<sup>rd</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> graders
