Monday	<p>Dear Heavenly Father,</p> <p>Thank you, Lord, that you are near to all who call on you in truth. You fulfill the desires of those who fear you; you hear their cries and save them. Thank you God for watching over all who love you. (Ps. 145:18-20) <b>Now I pray that _____ would not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, that he would present his requests to you, God. And I pray that your peace, which transcends all understanding, will guard his heart and mind in Christ Jesus.</b> (Phil. 4:6-7) For you, o Lord, are righteous in all your ways and faithful in all you do. May our mouths speak in praise of you, and may every creature praise your holy name forever and ever. (Ps. 145:17, 21) Amen.</p>
Tuesday	<p>Dear God,</p> <p>Thank you that you understand the way to wisdom. You alone know where it dwells, for you view the ends of the earth and see everything under the heavens. (Job 28:23-24) <b>So if _____ lacks wisdom, I pray that he would ask you, God, because you give generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him. But when he asks, I pray that he would believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.</b> (James 1:5-6) Now we praise you, Lord, for blessed are those who fear you and who find great delight in your commands. (Ps. 112:1) Amen.</p>
Wednesday	<p>Dear Lord,</p> <p>Walking in the way of your laws, we wait for you; your name and renown are the desire of our hearts. Our souls yearn for you in the night, and in the morning our spirits long for you. (Isa. 26:8-9) With this in mind, <b>I constantly pray for _____, that you may make him worthy of your calling, and that by your power you may bring to fruition his every desire for goodness and his every deed prompted by faith. Thursday	<p>Dear God,</p> <p>Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; love and faithfulness go before you. Blessed are those who have learned to acclaim you and who walk in the light of your presence, Lord. (Ps. 89:14-15) <b>And this is my prayer for _____: that his love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that he may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of you, God.</b> (Phil. 1:9-11) For we rejoice in your name all day long and celebrate your righteousness. You are our glory and strength, and by your favor you exalt our horn. (Ps. 89:16-17) Amen.</p>
Friday	<p>Dear Heavenly Father,</p> <p>Our frames were not hidden from you when we were made in the secret place, when we were woven together in the depths of the earth. Your eyes saw our unformed bodies, and all the days ordained for us were written in your book before one of them came to be. (Ps. 139:15-16) <b>Thank you for creating _____. I pray that no one would look down on him because he is young. Instead, I pray that he would set an example for the other believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.</b> (1 Tim. 4:12) For you created his inmost being; you knit him together in his mother's womb. We praise you because we are fearfully and wonderfully made. (Ps. 139:13-14) Amen.</p>
