

Dear Lee-Scott Academy Families,

After very careful consideration and in support of the health and wellness of all in our community, Lee-Scott Academy will suspend in-person classes and begin our transition to online learning, effective immediately, for three weeks. **The school will be closed March 16, 2020 - April 3, 2020, with classes resuming on Monday, April 6, 2020.**

Although we have no knowledge of any confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our school community, we feel this pivot to remote learning is the most prudent decision for us to make. **Information related to remote learning will be forthcoming.** To evaluate our families needs as we transition, please take a few minutes to complete the online survey so our IT department and administrators can work together to assess our families needs. AISA has suspended all AISA sponsored activities effective Sunday, March 15, 2020 through Sunday, April 5, 2020. This suspension will include all AISA sanctioned athletic events and academic programs/competitions. Individual coaches and faculty members responsible for athletic and academic teams will communicate with you about plans for practices and competitions once we receive further information from AISA at the end of this time period. In addition, all school-related events have been suspended through April 5. **We will evaluate scheduled school events (Prom, PTO Gala, Band Trip, ACT Test Date, etc.) to determine rescheduled dates or plans when our administrative team meets on Monday.**

This is not a decision we have made out of fear, but faith. 2 Timothy 1:7 says, "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind." While COVID-19 is impacting our cities, nation and our world in a very significant way, we are confident God is still in control. There has never been a moment our God was not loving, and to this day He has a purpose and a plan for our lives and this world.

We will continue to evaluate our situation over the next three weeks and provide updates through email as well.
