(a, and, away, big, blue, can, come, down, find, funny, for, go, help, here, I, in, is, it, jump, little, look, make, me, my, not, one, play, red, run, said, see, the, three, to, two, up, we, where, yellow, you) Play board games (Candy Land, Chutes and Ladders, Hi-Ho **Cherry O, Card games, Dominoes, Dice games)** Play with play-dough, sand, Crayola Model Magic to create letters, shapes, numbers, animals, etc... Be creative! This will strengthen your fine motor skills as well as help with letter and number identification. Use scissors, crayons, paper, glue, to create beautiful artwork. Take walks and talk, talk, talk with your parents. Work in your Moving Up To Kindergarten workbook and math packets. We can't wait to see your great work when we are back together. 😊 Practice counting small groups of items. Examples: 5 Q-tips, 7 spoons, 12 noodles, etc. Play with Legos, work puzzles, blocks, and spend lots of time OUTSIDE. We hope you have a fun, safe summer! Keep the learning going!
