Dear Lee-Scott Academy Family,

Lee-Scott Academy has developed a comprehensive set of procedures for all game day activities in response to COVID-19 with guidance from AISA, ADPH, and the CDC. These new policies and procedures are designed to protect all families, fans, and players – home and visiting schools. Our goal is to work together to give our student-athletes the opportunity to complete safely and in a healthy environment.

Attached to this email are game management details for football and volleyball. The following guidelines will apply to both sports. Please refer to the guidelines for each sport for additional information.

- Football Game Day Procedures August 14, 2020
- Volleyball Game Day Procedures August 14, 2020
- Masks are required on campus and while attending all games.
- Social distancing is required on campus and while attending all games.
- Fans must sit as a family unit and be a minimum of six feet away from other family units.
- Children must remain with an adult at all times. Children are not allowed to play in common areas, including playgrounds, green space, around the stands, or in any area around the stadium.

Warrior Spirit Walk - Thursday, August 20 @ 2:20pm

We will host a spirit walk on Thursday, August 20, on campus to kick-off the season! Parents may attend but will be asked to wear masks while on campus and socially distance around the cross area to allow students to be lined up on the sidewalks leading to the activities building.

Pep Rallies

Out of safety for our student-athletes, band members, students, and parents, we will not hold pep rallies at this point in the season inside Samford Gymnasium. We are unable to socially distance in the gym. We are planning for pep rallies to be held on Jud Scott Field knowing weather conditions are a factor. We are tentatively planning for the first pep rally to be held on Friday, September 4, before traveling to Glenwood.

Game-Day Parking

The two lanes coming into campus on game days will be a home lane and a visitor lane. The home lane will allow our fans to park in the side parking lot (part of this lot will be for Warrior Level Sponsor Parking), around the football field in the grass, and in the areas in the back of campus around the track. Visitors will not be allowed in these areas and will park in the front of the administration building, in the parking lot in front of academic buildings, and in the grassy areas on the front side of campus. This will eliminate crossover of fans into the stadium for games.

Pre-Purchasing Tickets

Tickets for football games will be available for presale on Wednesday and Thursday in the main office. Tickets are \$7 per adult and \$5 per student. LSA students are not required to purchase a ticket for home games. If you have season passes, please have these visible on game days to keep traffic moving on campus.

Livestream and Radio Broadcasts and How to Access

We are grateful for the partnerships with both the Lee-Scott Sports Radio Network and Kate 99.9 FM who will broadcast our football games this season. Fans will be able to watch a live stream of football games on the Lee-Scott Academy Facebook page and the Lee-Scott Sports Radio Network page. The radio team will bring you play-by-play action on 99.9 FM.

We are working to get live stream setup to be able to provide home volleyball games to our fans. More details coming soon on this platform!

Concessions

The band program has worked to safely provide concessions for attending fans. All items will be pre-packaged for purchase. Please follow the social distancing guidelines and directional patterns for access to the concession stand. Visitors will be provided their own concessions to eliminate crossover in the stadium. Thank you to our band boosters for working with us to provide this for our fans!
