

We started our new math curriculum, "My Math" by McGraw Hill in the second half of the 2020-21 school year with great success! It promises to be rigorous and follow current standards to better prepare our students. Our science curriculum from Savaas was in its second full year and is serving us very well. The content, resources, experiments, graphs/data, etc. are certain to improve ACT scores and provide the background knowledge our students need.

We have started the process of evaluating reading textbooks and will continue this process over this school year. Our current series "Wonders" by McGraw Hill has been updated and will be one of the numerous curriculum resources we will review. Teachers have already had samples in their hands to review and we will continue the process with our textbook committee. We will be continuing to meet regularly to discuss pros/cons, complete rubrics to assess and work to narrow choices that meet standards, follow the course of study, offer advanced opportunities for college preparation and support the mission of Lee-Scott Academy.

Some New Additions to the LSA Media Center

First, our new media specialist, Leslie Moore, is sure to be an exciting addition! She comes to Lee-Scott with an abundance of experience in education and a love for children and all things media!

Our LSA Media Center has gone through more renovations this summer! Over the last few years additions have included, new carpet, coffee bar with our very own LSA brew, "Warrior Roast," new student tables and numerous printed materials! 

Transportation Safety

- 1.) Teacher and student representatives will be at the front of the building at each pole to greet students, from 7:30-8:00 each morning. Please do not drop off students early.
- 2.) Dismissal carline begins at 2:50 each afternoon
- 3.) Please make sure to pull all the way up to allow for as many people to unload/load at a time as possible.



Dismissal procedures below:

During dismissal, we will continue our procedures of loading two lines to expedite the process in a safe, efficient manner. Thank you for your patience in the first days of school as we settle back into the routine with our children.

Please refrain from using your cell phone when you are in the LSA Car Line. There are a lot of moving parts during arrival and dismissal with a lot of children. It is crucial for everyone to be attentive.

If your child is meeting an Upper School sibling, considered a 3:00 student, a permission form must be completed and signed by the parent. Please remember that we do not have supervision for children after they leave the designated "3:00" area.


