Located in between Lee-Scott's current upper school and activities buildings, the new middle school building will primarily serve seventh and eighth grades. The new 11,000 square foot space will provide seven additional classrooms, a secure shelter in place area, two additional student bathrooms, a student services center, and a learning center that will also serve as a teacher workroom and additional restroom facilities.

"The purpose of these new classrooms isn't necessarily to add to our already student enrollment of 760, but to reduce class size and accommodate for more teachers so that the upper school can remain true to the school's goal of providing small class sizes," said Upper School Principal Ms. Donna Lloyd.

It was season to remember!










