I want you to know that on **Tuesday, January 31 at 6:00pm**, I will give the annual **State of the School Address**. We will meet in the cafeteria. A Lockdown Drill prepares students and staff to achieve maximum safety in the event of an imminent threat. Ideally, these drills are conducted without pre-announcement to give students and staff the opportunity to practice what to do in different scenarios.

I want you to know that LSA is hosting the **State AISA JV Basketball Tournament tomorrow - Saturday, January 21, 2023** in our gym. Games will begin at 9:00 am.
