New Student Applications and Re-enrollment: Current families should have received information about the re-enrollment process for the 2023-24 academic year in an email at the beginning of January and then another email with access to your student's enrollment form on January 9th. This allows you to have the

chance to secure your student's place on next year's class rolls, upon acceptance of your child's application for re-enrollment. This protected period will be offered through February 15th.

LSA continues to experience strong enrollment numbers. Therefore, it will be more important than ever for you to plan ahead for next year and apply to re-enroll your student in a timely manner. Please remember, current students are given priority over any prospective students that are interested in enrolling in our school. Acceptance notifications for new students will begin in early March. <u>LSA families who wish to enroll a sibling of a current LSA student will need to complete a New Student Application for that child.</u>

Don't forget to take advantage of our New Family Referral Program. Experience has taught us that word-of-mouth is one of the best methods of connecting prospective families with Lee-Scott Academy. We want to reward currently enrolled LSA families who choose to play an active role in supporting this important mission. Currently enrolled Lee-Scott Academy families, excluding employees, will receive a \$500 tuition credit for referring a new family to LSA.
