

In 1981, two independent schools, Lee Academy of Auburn and Scott Preparatory School of Opelika, merged to become Lee-Scott Academy. Originally located on the campus of Lee Academy, steady growth in enrollment led to the 1996 construction of our present campus in Auburn. Advanced College Prep Diploma

For an advanced college prep diploma, the student must pass 27 Carnegie units, including the following: English: 4 units; Mathematics: 4 units (including Algebra 2, Geometry, and Pre-Calculus); Science: 4 units (including Biology and Chemistry, Honors Physics or AP Biology); Social Studies: 4 units; World Language: 2 units (at least 2 consecutive years of the same language) Physical Education: 1 unit; Fine Arts: .5 unit; Health: .5 unit; Electives: 8 units

College Prep Diploma

For a college prep diploma, the student must pass 26 Carnegie units, including the following: English: 4 units; Mathematics: 4 units (including Algebra 2 and Geometry); Science: 4 units (including Biology and a Physical Science); Social Studies: 4 units; Physical Education: 1 unit; Fine Arts: .5 unit; Health: .5 unit; Electives: 8 units

Honor Graduates

Honor graduates are students who earn an Advanced Academic Diploma and have a core numerical average of 90 or above.

Students who successfully complete an Honors or Pre-AP Course with a semester average of 90+ receive an additional 5 points on their semester average for that course. In addition to the added 5 points, students receive an additional .5 quality point in their GPA.

Students who successfully complete an Advanced Placement or a Dual Enrollment Course with a semester average of 85+ receive an additional 10 points on their semester average for that course. Students also receive an additional 1 quality point in their GPA.

The Valedictorian and Salutatorian are determined by academic average, the numeric average of all academic courses taken at LSA in grades 9-12, including English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and World Language. The Valedictorian and Salutatorian must earn the Advanced College Prep Diploma. Lee-Scott Academy does not assign class rank.
