
















ALUMNI CAREER PANEL



NEW MIDDLE SCHOOL BUILDING

Lee-Scott Academy has completed its new middle school building. Seventh and eighth grade students will use the 11,000-square-foot facility, which can be found between the Activity Building and the Upper School. LSA's Upper School has 130 students enrolled in 7th and 8th grades. There are currently 789 students enrolled at Lee-Scott. "This is the largest enrollment that we have ever had and we have a waiting list for almost every grade level," Ms. Donna Lloyd, Upper School, principal said. The total cost for the project was approximately \$3 million. LSA Head of School, Dr. Stan Cox, said because of the support of our parents and other donors, Lee-Scott will remain debt-free. We are so thrilled for this new addition and are off to a great new school year.
