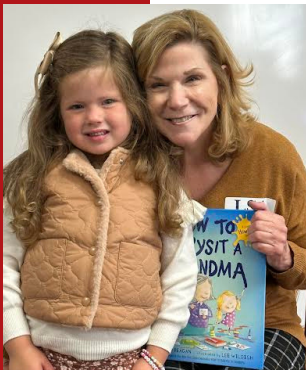


# LEE-SCOTT ACADEMY GRANDPARENT SOCIETY (GPS) NOVEMBER 2023

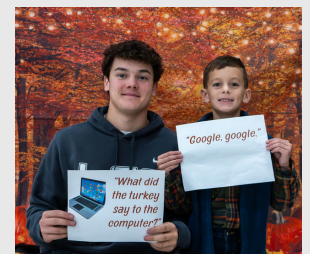
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## SENIOR/FIRST GRADE FRIENDS

Thankful for our Seniors and First Grade Friends

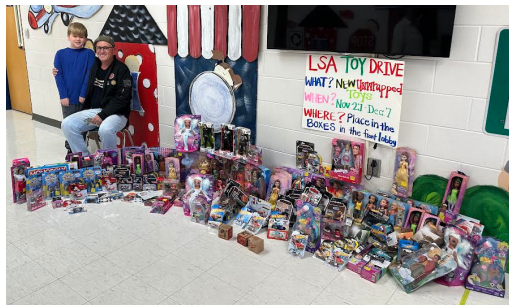

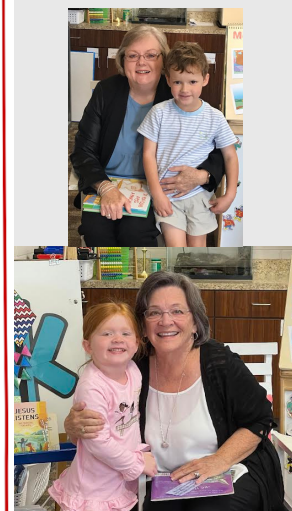
