Scholarship Opportunities for Lee Scott Academy Students

Graduating seniors attending Lee Scott Academy may be eligible for the scholarship opportunities listed below:

The **Dr. Jennifer Williamson Stone Memorial Scholarship** was established in 2021 as a tribute to Dr. Stone's excellence as a high school educator and a professor at Auburn University and to the compassion and faith she demonstrated daily. The scholarship benefits a graduating senior from Lee Scott Academy and Morgan Academy who has a minimum 3.5 GPA, a minimum ACT score of 25 and plans to attend Auburn University's main campus.

The **Jay Murphy Scholarship** benefits students who have the desire to become teachers. One scholarship is awarded with the amount determined annually (2023 award was \$1,186.00).

The **Jerry L. Bartley Memorial Scholarship** benefits high school graduating seniors who are active AAU basketball players. Eligible applicants will also reside in the state of Alabama and meet the academic initial-eligibility standards for NCAA Division I athletes. The amount of and number of awards will be determined annually.

The **Santee Family Fund Scholarship** benefits current or former residents of the Alabama Sheriffs Youth Ranches or other similar homes who are under the age of 25. The amount of and number of awards will be determined annually.

The **Todd Webb Scholarship** benefits graduates of any high school located in Alabama who will attend the University of Alabama and study in the College of Communication and Information Sciences. A focus on Sport Communication is preferred, but not required. One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded.

Scholarships are also available to benefit children of certain employees with these companies: Alfa, McInnis Construction, and Woerner Farms/Gulf South Transportation.
