



Scholarship Program for 2024 Graduating High School Seniors

Application Deadline: March 15, 2024

Instructions:

1. Complete the application form in its entirety. If you need more space than provided on this form, you may attach separate sheets of paper. PLEASE SUBMIT NEAT AND LEGIBLE PAGES ONLY.
2. Include ALL required attachments with your completed application form.

Students selected as scholarship recipients will be notified by the email address listed on the application in May 2024.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior, planning to attend a two-year, four-year or technical college.
2. **The applicant must be a member of All In Credit Union and reside in our service area.**
A parent, grandparent or other family member's account will not qualify the applicant as a member.
3. The applicant must be a U.S. citizen.
4. The applicant **must submit all required attachments** with the completed application form.

Selection Criteria:

Applicants will be selected based on:

1. Financial need
2. Character and leadership (i.e. extra-curricular involvement, honors, awards, achievements, personal references)
3. Essay responses (communication skills, personal insight)
4. Scholastic achievement (i.e. AP/Honors classes, grade point average, SAT or ACT scores, if available)

Required Attachments:

Please include all of the following with our completed application form. Any application forms that are submitted without these required attachments will be **ineligible**. Please review your package carefully before submitting it.

1. A copy of high school transcripts with your GPA, honors/AP classes and SAT or ACT scores noted, if available.
2. A copy of the notification of acceptance from an **accredited two-year, four-year or technical college**. This scholarship is only for 2024 graduating high school seniors.
3. The adjusted gross income from both parent's tax returns must be included in section #13 of the application. If your parents have not filed their taxes by April 15, 2024, please send a copy of their tax extension form and their adjusted gross income(s) from their 2023 tax returns. If you are qualified as one of the scholarship finalists a copy of your parents' tax returns must be submitted to All In Credit Union before the scholarship check can be disbursed. If the adjusted gross income reported on the application does not match the tax return, the applicant could be disqualified.
4. A senior portrait (or similar photo) of the applicant that can be used for press release and social media purposes, if selected as a scholarship recipient.

Additional Requirements/Final Judging Round

If you are selected to proceed to the final judging round, you will be notified and asked to verify the facts stated in your application by providing the following materials:

1. Current, official high school transcripts with school seal, including SAT or ACT scores, if available.
2. An updated notification of acceptance to an accredited two-year, four-year or technical college.

Awards:

A total of 28 scholarships for \$2,500.00 will be given out to deserving graduating high school seniors throughout our service area, which includes portions of Alabama, Florida and Mississippi.
