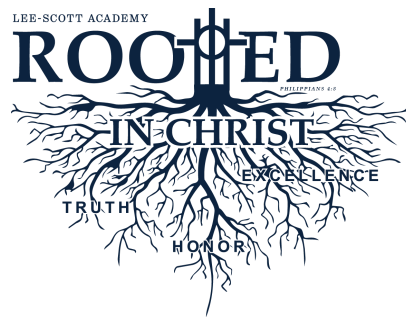


# Welcome to the 2026-2027 School Year!

## Arrival and Dismissal for Lower School

Please remember that we LOVE for our students to be at school as close to 7:30am as possible. Having time to settle into the day and prepare in the morning allows our students to be better prepared for the day ahead. Students are late after 7:55 in the Lower School and parents should check in at the office.



Teachers will be on duty from 2:45 until 3:05 to begin dismissal. Students not picked up by 3:05, will report to the main office to call a parent and await pickup. This has served us well in having the majority of our Lower School families off campus before Upper School releases.

K4 students must be signed in and out at the K4 entrance.

K4 parents must park in the main parking lot and walk up to get their child to sign him/her out. Older siblings will be allowed to sit with their K4 sibling for convenience of pick up.

Please make teachers aware of this request.

## Communication

Please use the following reminders concerning communication:

- 1.) Please remember that during the day, teachers will be teaching and are responsible for students. Oftentimes, they will have meetings or professional development during their planning time/period and may not be able to respond to emails. Their priority is being engaged with students.
- 2.) Teachers may not get emails about alternate plans for dismissal. If there is a substitute, they do not have access to email. If you have a change of transportation, please make our school office aware so that they may communicate with the teacher or substitute.
- 3.) Please give teachers a 24 hour window for returning your calls and/or emails, remembering that they have families and responsibilities after school as well and will not respond later in the day or evening. They are not required to respond to emails on weekends.
- 4.) Teachers will not be available in the mornings to talk with parents at the door. If you need to talk with teachers, please make sure to email or set up a time to talk with them. They want to give you their full attention, but can't do this at arrival. They are expected to greet and engage with the students in their classroom, starting at 7:30am.
- 5.) If at all possible, please avoid absences and checkouts that interfere with instructional time. It is hard for students to miss this time with teachers and make this up.

## School Spirit

We love to support our Warrior teams! In the Lower School, we have football and cheerleading for 5th and 6th grade students, but have numerous teams that you can support with family and friends! We want to build community and foster support with attendance at our various athletic, band and school sponsored events. Please keep up with athletic schedules and come join the fun!



## Safety Information

We have drills for fire, severe weather and intruders. Some drills are announced and others are unannounced. We also take traffic safety seriously due to the volume of students arriving and leaving campus daily. Please see some of our traffic reminders and updates below:

- 1.) Teacher and student representatives will be at the front of the building at each pole to greet students each morning. We love for students to arrive as close to 7:30am as possible and are considered late after 7:55am. If arriving after 7:55, students will need to check in at the main office. Please do not drop off students early. They are not supervised before 7:30am.
- 2.) Please make sure to pull all the way up to allow for as many people to unload/load at a time as possible.
- 3.) Dismissal carline begins at 2:45 - 2:55pm each afternoon.
- 4.) Any child not going through the carline, will be picked up at the side door. That includes siblings, babysitters, alternate transportation, etc. ANYONE picking students up in the carline or side door, **MUST** have a school issued hang tag.

### Additional Safety Reminders Below:

- During dismissal, we will continue our procedures of loading two lines to expedite the process in a safe, efficient manner. Thank you for your patience in the first days of school as we settle back into the routine with our children.
- Please **refrain from using your cell phone** when you are in the LSA Car Line. There are a lot of moving parts during arrival and dismissal with a lot of children. It is crucial for everyone to be attentive for student safety.
- If a family has an emergency that prevents pick-up at the traditional time, please notify the front office and know that students will be sent to the office from supervised dismissal to wait there.
- Students should not remain on campus after school unless they are participating in an activity (club, tutoring, required athletic practice, etc.). Students **should not be unsupervised at school functions or on campus** in the after school hours, **including athletic events.**

## Birthday Celebrations

We are thrilled to host monthly birthday celebrations collectively in the cafeteria for students who share birthdays within the month for grades 1-6!

In an effort to protect instructional time, we DO NOT have individual birthdays in classrooms for 1st-6th grades. Remember that **parents should not bring treats on the individual birthdays for those grades.**

PTO provides the treats each month for each grade level. You are always welcome to bring lunch and have your child sit with you for this event. The cafeteria celebration is a fun-filled LSA tradition!

Officer Jon Young announces the birthdays and the cafeteria full of students singing Happy Birthday or acknowledging by standing to celebrate!

K4/Kindergarten parents and homeroom teachers will organize for individual birthdays because these grade levels eat in their classrooms.
